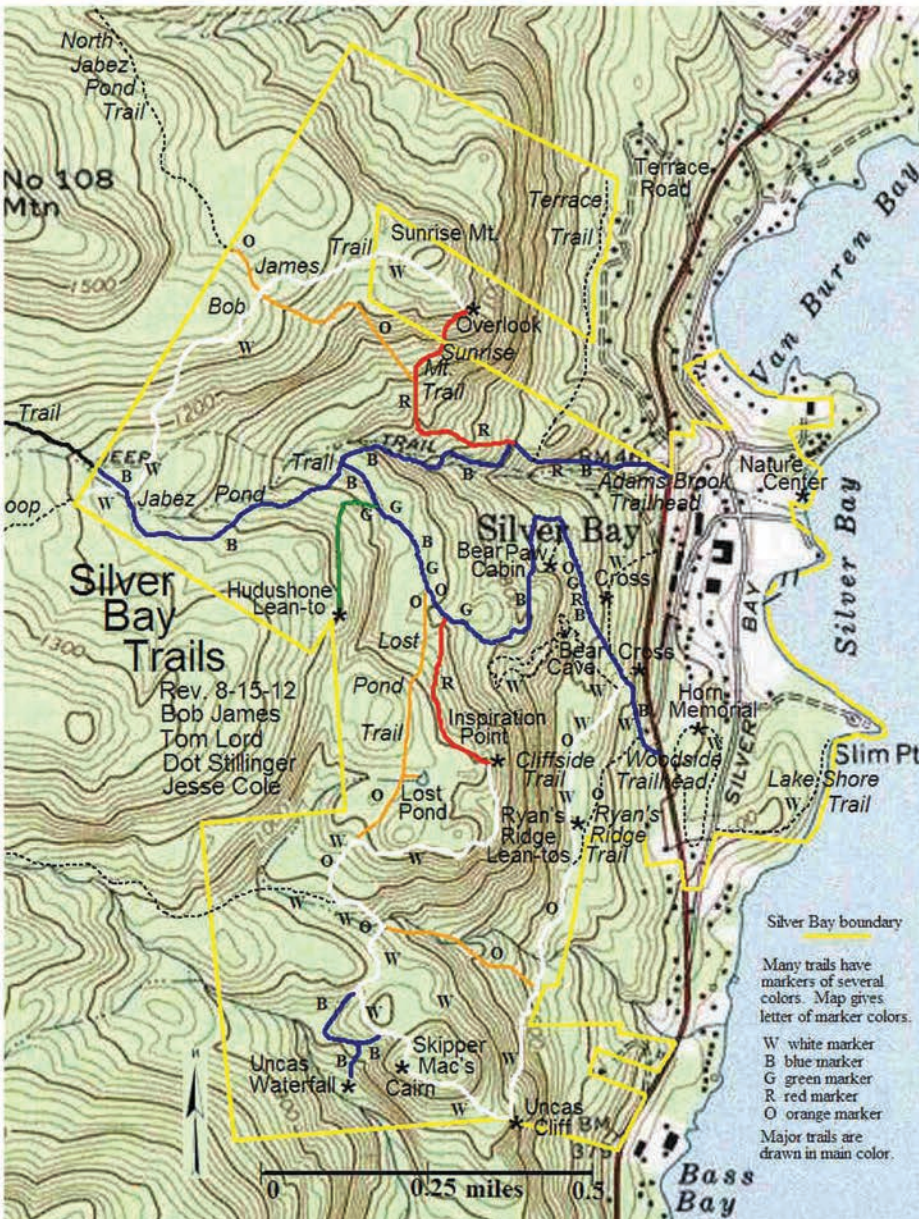

WOODSIDE TRAILHEAD (located across 9N from the Silver Bay Service Road)

Red Trail

•*Inspiration Point:* A moderate trail which comes into the back of Inspiration Point from the north. The trail comes up the old Woodside logging road and takes hikers through a lovely beech forest. 1.5 mi one way.

White Trail

•*Ryan's Ridge:* An easy hike located all the cliff below Inspiration Point. In 2007 two lean-tos were built in memory of Ryan Dickson, a long-time member and Emp at Silver Bay. This area is designated as a camping site for Silver Bay Children's programs. 0.25 mile one way.

•*Uncas Cliff:* A moderate trail with mixed terrain and variable inclines. It provides a wonderful view of the lake. 0.75 mile one way.

•*Skipper Mac's Cairn:* A moderate trail with the best southerly view of the lake. 1.0 mile one way.

•*Uncas Waterfall:* This blue trail is a short detour off the white trail. It leads to a small but picturesque waterfall. 1.25 mile one way.

•*Inspiration Point:* A moderate trail which comes into the back of Inspiration Point from the south.

Orange Trail

•*Lost Pond Loop:* Hike to a small swampy pond in a natural Adirondack setting.

By way of the Jabez Pond Trail - a moderate trail offering a great walk after an uphill climb. 1.0 mile one way.

By way of the Uncas Trail - a moderate trail offering another great walk but does also have an uphill climb. 1.25 mile one way.

Blue Trail

•*Jabez Pond Trail:* A moderate trail that mostly climbs with some flat sections and ends at a magnificent pond nestled in undisturbed public land in the Adirondack Park.

Green Trail

•*Hudushone Lean-to Trail:* A moderate trail that follows an old logging road and ends with some of the best views of Lake George. The lean-to was built in 2001 as a camping site for Silver Bay Children's Program. 1.0 mile one way.

ADAM'S BROOK TRAILHEAD (located across 9N from Hillcrest Cottage)

Red Trail

•*Sunrise Mountain:* A difficult trail with rocky terrain and steep inclines; one of Silver Bay's most challenging hikes. 0.75 mile one way.

White Trail

•*Bob James Trail:* A moderate to difficult trail which connects Sunrise Mountain to the Jabez Pond Trail. It offers a steady climb and much easier access to Sunrise Mountain from the west. 0.75 mile one way.

Blue Trail

•*Jabez Pond Trail:* A moderate trail that mostly climbs with some flat sections and ends at a magnificent pond nestled in undisturbed public land in the Adirondack Park.

Orange Trail

•*North Jabez Trail:* A moderate trail that climbs to state land and the north end of Jabez Pond. 1.25 mile one way.

HORN MEMORIAL NATURE TRAIL (trailhead located across Silver Bay Road from the Fisher Gymnasium parking lot)

Follow the white markers along a short, peaceful, moderate trail with 30 stations highlighting Adirondack flora. 1.25 mile round trip.

LAKESHORE TRAIL (trailhead located on the south side of Slim Point beach from the Fisher Gymnasium parking lot)

Gorgeous mini-trail with white markers. The steep climb is very short with wonderful lake views. 0.5 mile one way.
