We are now accepting applications for **Young Adult Field Secretary** of New York Yearly Meeting of the Religious Society of Friends (Quakers).

The New York Yearly Meeting Young Adult Field Secretary works with young adult Friends in the NYYM area in the following ways: serving as a locus and a catalyst for networking; disseminating information; assisting in multi-generational community development; doing mentoring, pastoral care, coordinating, and outreach; and helping young adult Friends to develop their gifts and to find a home in the Religious Society of Friends. In addition, the position will support young adult Friends' retreats and activities and opportunities for religious education and will serve as a support and focal point for college outreach efforts. This is a half-time position that requires ongoing ministry and considerable travel, including many weekend commitments, around the NYYM area. Applicants should be a member of the Religious Society of Friends (or a committed and active participant in Friends' activities) with a strong understanding of Quaker ministry, testimonies, structures, history, and practice; have strong verbal and written communication skills; be skilled at recognizing and supporting the gifts of others; be skilled in relationship building; and have experience with social media.

Applications are being accepted until June 15, 2017. The position starts July 15.
