## Support the HALT Solitary Confinement Act

The Humane Alternatives to Long-Term (HALT) Solitary Confinement Act provides the following key mechanisms to challenge isolated confinement:

- > Creates Alternatives to Isolated Confinement, including Residential Rehabilitation Units (RRUs)
- ➤ Ends Long Term Isolated Confinement
- > Restricts Criteria for Placement in Isolated Confinement or RRUs
- Bans Special Populations from Isolated Confinement

HALT Solitary Confinement Act also provides the following key procedural and other protections:

- > Enhances Due Process Protections Before Placement In Isolated Confinement or RRUs
- > Creates Mechanisms for Return from RRUs to General Population
- > Covers all categories of people who currently face isolated confinement
- Mandates training, reporting, and outside oversight
