On February 22, Friends World Committee on Consultation (FWCC) hosted the first worldwide <u>online</u> <u>conference</u> on sustainability, asking Friends, 'How does God call us to act?' During the conference, a group of Elders were listening to the spoken ministry. After the conference they wrote <u>a reflective statement</u>. This cannot be an epistle for the conference, because those

gathered did not have the chance to approve it. However, it can act as a sense of where Friends are today, and it can help prepare Friends for the next FWCC World Plenary in 2023.


