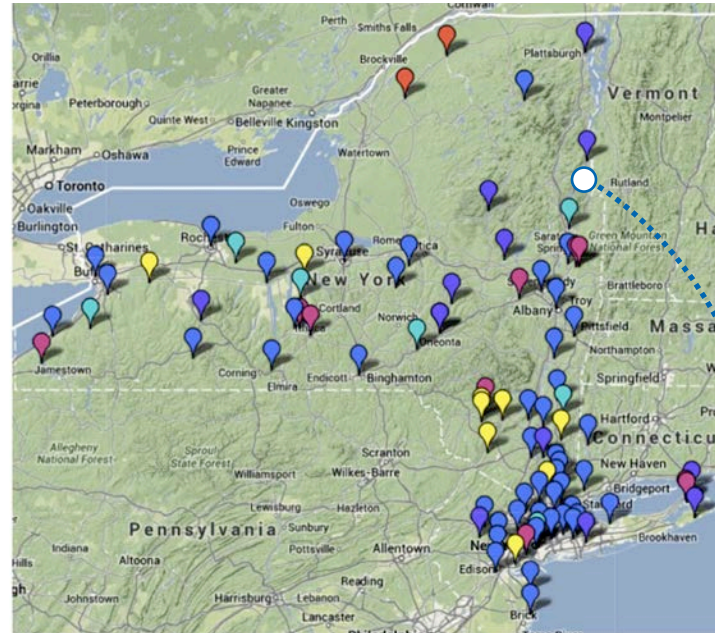
No one should let financial concerns keep them away!

Financial assistance is available – The Equalization Fund was created specifically to ensure that everyone who wants to attend, can. Just follow these simple steps:

1. Find out if your monthly, quarterly or regional Meetings have funds for you to attend, and the amount.
2. Have your Meeting email the NYYM office a confirmation of the amount that has been granted even if it's zero.
3. Fill out the Financial Assistance section at the bottom of your registration form – what you expect to receive from your home Meeting and the amount you need from the Equalization Fund.

Scholarships typically provide up to one third the cost of lower price housing, but may provide more depending on need. If you have a physical condition that limits your mobility and your access to lower-priced housing units, please give us that information on the form.
